

## Further Instructions for Students / Teachers / Parents

### **For Std. V, only for this year (2025-2026)**

\* Students who get 40 or more marks but less than 50 marks are eligible only for certificate, but not eligible for Level II.

\*\* Students who get 50 or more marks are eligible for Ganit Prabhutwa Spardha (Level II).

### **For Std. VII and Std. VIII**

\* Students who get 40 or more marks but less than 55 marks are eligible only for certificate of merit

\*\* Students who get 55 or more marks are eligible for certificate of merit and for Ganit Prabhutwa Spardha (Level II).

The **certificates** of all students will be sent to their schools / residence (depending upon type of registration) up to 2<sup>nd</sup> week of February 2026.

The **hall-tickets** of all the students selected for level II examination will be sent by e-mail to the schools / parents of respective students.
